- Wave creates interactive virtual entertainment experiences for artists to connect with audiences worldwide.
- The company harnesses cutting-edge broadcast technology and real-time gaming graphics to transform any artist into their own digital avatar, who can perform live; allowing fans to enjoy and interact with them in a virtual, gaming universe.
- Virtual concerts are distributed via YouTube, Twitch, Facebook, as well as other major digital and gaming channels.
- To date, the company has hosted more than 50 Wave events for a number of popstars, DJs and artists.
- Wave's roster of artist includes John Legend Galantis, Tinashe, TOKiMONSTA, Imogen Heap, REZZ, and electronic violinist, Lindsey Stirling whose recent Wave was attended by over 400,000 people from across the world on YouTube, Twitch and Lindsey's own Facebook page.
- The company has also worked with companies such as Warner Bros for re-creating the VR music club scene in the "Ready Player One" blockbuster, with others in the works.
